### **Manifesting the Sons of God–The Name of Jesus, Nov 14, 2012**

**Review: Manifesting the Sons of God–The Name of Jesus, Nov 14, 2012**

When Jesus entered into a new blood covenant with us, He gave us His name to use. Just as God exchanged names with Abram as part of the old blood covenant, Jesus gave us His name in the new blood covenant.

John 14:12–14, “Verily, verily I say unto you, he that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.”

John 16:23–24 says, “Verily, verily, I say unto you, whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.”

This is one of the most powerful truths in scripture! It does not say if you have enough faith. It does not say if you’ve prayed or studied long enough. It says if you ask anything in Jesus name, Jesus will do it. This is how the body of Christ is supposed to multiply. The weakest son in the body of Christ can use Jesus name. All the grace, power, health, blessing and life that Jesus’ name carries, is available to every believer. Praise God!

Phil 2:–11 says, “God hath highly exalted Him, and give Him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth.” We see the use of Jesus name by the disciples in Acts 3:6, “In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.” Peter explained that it was not his own power or holiness that made the lame man walk. Acts 3:16 says “His name through faith in His name made this man strong.” Peter simply used the authority and healing power in the name of Jesus. That same authority is given to everyone of us.

If anyone is being held down by the enemy, it is time for them to rise up in the Mighty Name of Jesus! The enemy and opposition will bow in Jesus’ name. The truth is that the enemy has no power left. The enemy is under our feet! It is time for the believer to receive the deliverance that Jesus purchased with His own blood. We then need to go and set others free in the Name of Jesus!

**Prayer 1: 3 Minutes:**

We are going to thank God that He has given us the name of Jesus. We are going to pray as the disciples prayed in Acts 4:29–30. “Lord, grant unto thy servant all boldness to speak thy Word. By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.”

**Prayer 2: 3 Minutes:**

We will be praying for a harvest of souls this week.

Ask the Lord of the Harvest to whistle to all his sheep in Lagos, Oakland, Colorado Springs, and every fellowship around the country. Ask the Holy Spirit to drive them into church and into every fellowship with His irresistible wind. We will also be praying for the Holy Spirit to convict them of their sins, so they will be saved, and Christ will be formed and complete in all of the people present.

**Prayer 3: 3 minutes**

We are going to thank God for all past signs and wonders, and that signs and wonders will erupt this week in all of the services and fellowships. Pray for miracles that will gather unbelieving crowds into church.

**Prayer 4: 3 Minutes**

We are going to thank God for His servant, Bishop Oyedepo, and everyone who serves in the body of Christ. Pray that the Word of God will flow freely and be glorified in every service and fellowship. Pray that all the ministers will speak with flames of fire.
