### **The Gospel of the Kingdom, Nov 21, 2012**

**Opening prayer:**

**Review: The Gospel of the Kingdom, 2012**

Scripture is clear that we are to proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom. This is different than the Gospel of Salvation, which is not a scriptural gospel to proclaim. Luke 24:44–49 tells us that Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms talk about Jesus. Jesus tells us that Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead on the third day. After He fulfilled scripture, we were to preach repentance and the remissions of sins. Jesus would ascend to heaven and send the promise of His Father, which is the Holy Spirit. The Old Testament predicts what will happen. The New Testament tells us that “it happened.”

We will cover the prediction, prayer, proclamation and the proof of the Kingdom.

**Prediction of the Kingdom:** Isaiah 9:6–7 tells us a child will be born and He will establish a new kingdom.

Is 53:4–5 tells us Jesus will pay the price for our transgressions, or sins, and by His stripes we were healed. Psalm 103:2–3 says, “The Lord will forgive all thine iniquities; and healeth all thy diseases.” Malachi 4:2 tells us the same thing. “The Sun of righteousness shall arise with healing in His wings.” Jesus will take our sin and give us His righteousness. He will also heal our mind and physical body.

Scripture also predicts He will send us the promise of the Father, which is the Holy Spirit. The presence of the Holy Spirit is called the anointing. Is 10:27 tells us every burden will be removed and yoke destroyed when the Holy Spirit comes. Joel 2:23–26 explains that the Holy Spirit will be poured out on all flesh. The anointing will fill your floors with wheat and restore anything the enemy has stolen.

**Prayer of the Kingdom:** Math 6:9–10 says we are to pray, “Thy Kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.” Our prayers are supposed to bring heaven down to earth. We know there is no sickness, strife, poverty or failure in heaven. We are to bring the same situation to earth.

**Proclamation of the Kingdom:**

John the Baptist proclaimed in Math 3:1–2, “Repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.” Jesus preached the same thing. Math 4:17 says, “Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

Jesus left no doubt that scripture was talking about Him in Luke 4:17–21. He told them that He was the anointed one that was sent to preach the gospel. Jesus was quoting Isaiah 61. Jesus said, “This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.”

## **Proof of the Kingdom:**

Scripture tells us that when the gospel of the Kingdom is preached that there will always be signs, or proofs to demonstrate that the Kingdom is real. The gospel of the Kingdom was never meant to be preached without signs to prove it is real.

Acts 2:38 says, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.” When you believe the gospel of the kingdom, you are born again and will receive the Holy Spirit. The anointing of the Holy Spirit will remove every burden and destroy every yoke. We now can use His name, which means “The Anointed One.” The anointing in the name of Jesus causes everything with a name to bow. Math 18:18–19 also tells us we now have authority to bind and loose. Because of the anointing, we can demonstrate the Kingdom of God to others.

Mark 16:15–18 says, “Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved...And these signs SHALL FOLLOW THEM THAT BELIEVE; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues, they shall take up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.” He will always confirm the gospel of the Kingdom with signs following! Praise God!

## **Prayer 1: 3 Minutes:**

We are going to pray as the disciples prayed in Acts 4:29–30. “Lord, grant unto thy servants all boldness to speak thy Word. By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.” We are going to thank God that the anointing of the Holy Spirit removes every burden and destroys every yoke in every believer’s life.

## **Prayer 2: 3 Minutes:**

We will be praying for a harvest of souls this week.

Ask the Lord of the Harvest to whistle to all his sheep in Lagos, Oakland, Colorado Springs, and every fellowship around the country. Ask the Holy Spirit to drive them into church and into every fellowship with His irresistible wind. We will also be praying for the Holy Spirit to convict them of their sins, so they will be saved, and Christ will be formed and complete in all of the people present.

## **Prayer 3: 3 minutes**

We are going to thank God for all past signs and wonders, and that signs and wonders will erupt this week in all of the services and fellowships. Pray for miracles that will gather unbelieving crowds into church.

## **Prayer 4: 3 Minutes**

We are going to thank God for His servant, Bishop Oyedepo, and everyone who serves in the body of Christ. Pray that the Word of God will flow freely and be glorified in every service and fellowship. Pray that all the ministers will speak with flames of fire.
