### **The Gospel of the Kingdom, A Kingdom of Kings and Priests, Nov 28, 2012**

**Review: The Gospel of the Kingdom, A Kingdom of Kings and Priests, Nov 28, 2012**

Rev 5:10 says, "He has made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth." Jesus took all of God's judgment for our sins on the cross. He was sacrificed and presented His blood to the Father in heaven. That act has totally fulfilled the old covenant and has restored our fellowship with Him. We now have the power to reign as kings and priests. It was totally an act of grace by God himself.

Rom 5:17 says, "For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ." Grace is unmerited favor. We did nothing to deserve it. We also have the gift of righteousness. This means all of our offences have been completely paid for. So we have the ability to reign in life by receiving the gift that Jesus gave us. The secret to reigning in life is to receive the abundance of grace and gift of righteousness that has been freely given to us.

Most believers are not reigning in life because they are still trying to achieve a level of power, wealth, righteousness, etc. You can never achieve it. This keeps believers in doubt. They are always wondering whether or not they have fasted enough, read the Bible enough, prayed enough, or worked hard enough. They think maybe they are not receiving because God is judging them for a bad decision they made in the past. Maybe they don't have enough faith. In the new covenant, God keeps no record of sin. The victory has already been achieved by God. Not you! Praise God that it is dependent on Him and not our works. It is a gift. It is no longer by works. We can rest in Jesus finished work on the cross.

Here is a simple way to determine whether or not you are living in the abundance of grace, or whether you are still trying to achieve. If you know you are already victorious by what Jesus did on the cross, you are living in the new covenant of grace. If it is based on what you did or didn't do, you are still trying to achieve grace and righteousness. There is nothing you can do in the new covenant other than believe Jesus accomplished your victory on the cross.

2 Peter 1:2-3 says, "Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, according as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that has called us to glory and virtue." All things have been freely given to you. Everything has been freely given to us. There is nothing we can do to earn it. Rest in this truth. You have

been given an abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness to reign in life as kings and priests. Praise God!

**Prayer 1: 3 Minutes:**

We are going to ask God to open our eyes of understanding in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, and that grace and peace is multiplied to us, in Jesus mighty name! 2 Peter 1:2-3

**Prayer 2: 3 Minutes:**

We will be praying for a harvest of souls this week.

Ask the Lord of the Harvest to whistle to all his sheep in Lagos, Oakland, Colorado Springs, and every fellowship around the country. Ask the Holy Spirit to drive them into church and into every fellowship with His irresistible wind. We will also be praying for the Holy Spirit to convict them of their sins, so they will be saved, and Christ will be formed and complete in all of the people present.

**Prayer 3: 3 minutes**

We are going to thank God for all past signs and wonders, and that signs and wonders will erupt this week in all of the services and fellowships. Pray for miracles that will gather unbelieving crowds into church.
