

Enter Into God's Rest And Allow His Power to Flow – Part 2



Colossians 2:16 So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or **sabbaths**, 17 which are a shadow of things to come, **but the substance is of Christ.**

Hebrews 10:1 For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.

Hebrews 11:1 **Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.**



Hebrews 4:1 Therefore, since the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us be careful that none of you be found to have fallen short of it. 2 For we also have had the good news proclaimed to us, just as they did; but the message they heard was of no value to them, because they did not share the faith of those who obeyed.

3 Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has said, “So I declared on oath in my anger, ‘They shall never enter my rest.’”

And yet his works have been finished since the creation of the world.



Galatians 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but **faith working through love**.

God is not dealing with us based on judgment. Instead the creator of the universe was willing to die for us!

Working – Strong's 1754 – energe'ō – Helps word studies: energize, working in a situation which brings it from one stage (point) to the next, like an electrical current energizing a wire, bringing it to a shining light bulb.



The true rest of God is understanding that Jesus finished everything we will ever need.

The truth is every financial need, every breakthrough, all of our joy has already been accomplished!!

Most of us are praying, pleading with God to “maybe” come through for us.

True rest is knowing it has already been accomplished.



So how do we enter into His rest?

Philippians 4:6 (NLT) Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. 7 Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.



You are already victorious, prosperous, whole, healed, protected IN CHRIST!

Enter into God's rest. Focus on the fact that whatever you are desiring has already been finished. When you change your focus, the power of God flows out of your spirit and brings about the desired result!
