

**We Are Blessed With Every
Spiritual Blessing**



Romans 4:13 For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

16. Therefore *it is* of faith that *it might be* according to grace, so that the promise might be **sure to all the seed**, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham

Sure – 949 bebaios – Helps Word Studies – (literally – solid enough to walk on, firm, unshakeable, absolutely dependable)



Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, *who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,* **4** just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, **5** having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, **6** to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.



Most teaching states that Christians can only enjoy their blessings when they get to heaven.

“Spiritual blessing” has to do with how the blessing is obtained, or the source of the blessing.

Our blessings come from Christ, not our efforts, law keeping or our physical birth (i.e. Jewish)



How Many Blessings Do We Have?

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every (pas – all, the whole, every kind) spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ



What kind of blessings do we have?

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every **spiritual** blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ

Spiritual – pneumatikos – not carnal, emanating from the Divine Spirit, or exhibiting its effects and so its character, produced by the sole power of God, supernatural



Where do we experience these blessings?

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ

In Christ, meaning in Christ's body, which is the church.



The source of our blessings are spiritual, not from human effort.

We can enjoy every supernatural blessing right now as the body of Christ.

We don't have to worry or labor for His supernatural favor. We can simply come to our Father with prayer and thankfulness and freely receive everything that Christ Jesus worked for.
