

# **Seeing and Hearing God**

## **- Part 2**



**Jeremiah 31:31** “Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah...

**33** But this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. **34** No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.”



**Jeremiah 33:3** 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

Everyone can see and hear God for themselves. It is a covenant.

You do not need to pray/fast and twist God's arm for Him to speak. It's a guarantee that you will see and hear God in the New Covenant



**John 14:19** Before long, the world will not see me anymore, **but you will see me**. Because I live, you also will live. **20** On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you. **21** Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and **I too will love them and show myself to them.**”



**John 16:16** Jesus went on to say, “In a little while you will see (theh-o-reh’-o) me no more, and then after a little while you will see (hor-ah’-o) me.”

(theh-o-reh’-o) – see, gaze – primarily means to see with your eyes

(hor-ah’-o) – see, often with metaphorical meaning: “to see with the mind” (i.e. Spiritually see)



**2 Corinthians 3:15** But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. **16** Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. **17** Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty. **18** But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed (metamorphoo – changed, transfigured after being with) into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.



When you look at the face of Jesus –

You become more and more like Him effortlessly – it supernaturally produces results that trying harder, legalism, religious works can never do

Hearts and wrong beliefs are healed, physical healings and emotional healings take place, begin to change from the inside out - “from glory to glory”
