Mark 9:49 For everyone will be seasoned with fire

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.



1 Corinthians 3:1 | For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. **2** Now if anyone builds on this foundation *with* gold, silver, precious stones, **wood, hay, straw,** **3** each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. **4** If anyone's work which he has built on *it* endures, he will receive a reward. **5** If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; **but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.**



Revelation 14:10 He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb

Fire – Strong’s 4442 – HELPS Word-studies – fire, In Scripture is often used figuratively, like with the “fire of God” which transforms all it touches into light and likeness with itself

Brimstone – Strong’s Concordance 2303- theion – brimstone, sulfur

HELPS Word –studies – theion, sulfur, named for the sulfur smell left by lightning; (figuratively) the fire of HEAVEN, bringing down Gods judgment to display His awesome, unstoppable power



Revelation 20:13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of **fire**. This is the second death.

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Whatever your concept of hell is, it is in the presence of His all consuming love that never fails.

I believe in Hell. But scripture says His lake of fire ultimately consumes hell and death.

I believe Hell is for purification, not eternal damnation with no hope for escape. Is it possible someone could reject perfect love, in theory yes, but my hope is no.
