Review: Walking in the Anointing, Aug 29, 2012

We have been talking about the powerful effects of the anointing oil. When the anointing oil is applied, the Holy Spirit is released. You can walk in the anointing and keep the oil fresh twenty-four hours a day by the power of thanksgiving and praise. When you are in the presence of the Holy Spirit, the fresh anointing is released. Psalm 100:4 says, "Enter His gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise." Psalm 22:3 also says, "But thou are holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel." We can guarantee God's presence and the anointing of the Holy Spirit when we are in an attitude of thanksgiving and praise. When we are murmuring and complaining we diminish the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Scripture says the joy of the Lord is our strength. How does this work? Isaiah 61:3 gives us the secret. When we are joyful, the oil of the Holy Spirit is released. We know that all darkness has to flee in the presence of God! Our victory is guaranteed when we are walking in the anointing, Praise God!

Psalm 92:1,10 says, "It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High. My horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil." When we thank God for everything He has done in our lives, and praise Him for who He is, God guarantees He will anoint us with fresh oil.

We can look at Jesus as an example. When Jesus was faced with the death of Lazarus and the feeding of the 5,000, the first thing He did was say, "Father, I thank you." As Jesus thanked God, the power of the Holy Spirit was available to overcome the situation.

2 Chron 20:15–25 shows us another example of the power of praise. When you praise God, His presence guarantees victory in every battle. When King Jehoshaphat and his army sent out singers, God took over the battle and slaughtered the enemy. Verse 25 says, "It took Jehoshaphat and his people three days to gather the spoil, it was so much." God doesn't change. We know that when we are anointed, "He reproved kings for their sakes, saying touch not mine anointed." Scripture also says in Joel 2:24 that the anointing of the Holy Spirit guarantees, "The floors shall be full of wheat, and the fats shall overflow with wine and oil." When we are thankful and sing praises to God, God takes over our battles and "the earth yields her increase" (Psalm 67:5–6).

It's time for the body of Christ to stop looking at what they don't have and start praising God for Who they have. The things you have been praying about will be

accomplished with divine speed when you learn the power of praise. When we are thankful and praiseful, God pours out the fresh oil! Praise God!

Prayer 1: 3 Minutes:

We are going to thank God for everything He has done in our lives. We are going to praise Him for His greatness! We will be anointed with fresh oil. Psalm 114 tells us in the presence of God, the seas flee and are driven back. The mountains in our lives will skip like rams. Our floors will be full of wheat and our fats overflowing with wine and oil!

Prayer 2: 3 Minutes:

We will be praying for a harvest of souls this week.

Ask the Lord of the Harvest to whistle to all his sheep in Lagos, Oakland, Colorado Springs, and every fellowship around the country. Ask the Holy Spirit to drive them into church and into every fellowship with His irresistible wind. We will also be praying for the Holy Spirit to convict them of their sins, so they will be saved, and Christ will be formed and complete in all of the people present.

Prayer 3: 3 minutes

We are going to thank God for all past signs and wonders, and that signs and wonders will erupt this week in all of the services and fellowships. Pray for miracles that will gather unbelieving crowds into church.

Prayer 4: 3 Minutes

We are going to thank God for His servant, Bishop Oyedepo, and everyone who serves in the body of Christ. Pray that the Word of God will flow freely and be glorified in every service and fellowship. Pray that all the ministers will speak with flames of fire.

Offering: 5 minutes (Share one scripture and then take the offering.)
