Review: The Blood Covenant - Part 3 - It's Called Grace Because We Don't Deserve It

God wants us to know that His covenant with us is sure and secure. Psalm 89:34 says, "My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Jesus shed His own blood and promised that, "In blessing I will bless."

Hope is the confident expectation of good things to come. No matter what situation you are in, we can rest in the fact that "all things work together for our good." We have an unbreakable covenant of grace. We can be sure that good will always come because Jesus cut a blood covenant and said, "In blessing I will bless!" He doesn't say He will bless if we are obedient. He says He will bless us, period!

Thank God that the covenant is not based on our obedience. That makes us insecure. We will always wonder if we did everything right!

Belief in Jesus makes God's blessing, favor and victory sure! We never have to wonder! You are forever blessed with faithful Abraham!
