Ask and Receive So that Your Joy May Be Full



Leviticus 16:8 Then Aaron shall cast lots for the two goats: one lot for the Lord and the other lot for the scapegoat. 9 And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the Lord's lot fell, and offer it as a sin offering. IO But the goat on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat shall be presented alive before the Lord, to make atonement upon it, and to let it go as the scapegoat into the wilderness.



Matthew 27:17 Now at the feast the governor was accustomed to releasing to the multitude one prisoner whom they wished. 16 And at that time they had a notorious prisoner called Barabbas. 17 Therefore, when they had gathered together, Pilate said to them, "Whom do you want me to release to you? Barabbas, or Jesus who is called Christ?" 19 While he was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent to him, saying, "Have nothing to do with that just Man, for I have suffered many things today in a dream because of Him."



Matthew 27:20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitudes that they should ask for Barabbas and destroy Jesus. 21 The governor answered and said to them, "Which of the two do you want me to release to you?"

- **25** And all the people answered and said, "His blood be on us and on our children."
- **26** Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered *Him* to be crucified.



Galatians 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" **7** Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

John 16:23 "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. **24** Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full. (Ask – Strong's 154 (ahee-teh'-o) – Ask, request, require, demand)

Philippians 4:6 Be anxious (a part, as opposed to a whole) for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests (ahee-the'-o - Ask, request, require, demand) be made known to God;

7 and the peace (i-ray'-nay – to join, tie together into a whole) of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.



There is no struggle or long agonizing prayer and fasting. You are an heir!

How do you get it? Simply ask as a son! You have the shalom or oneness with Jesus and the Father.

Keep focused on the solution, and it will come to pass.
