Son in the Kingdom

- Your are a joint-heir with Christ Jesus
- You don't receive your inheritance by "having enough faith"
- You receive it by changing what you believe about yourself

Sonship was always by faith, not through works or your obedience

The New Covenant is believing what's true about Jesus is true about you!

Romans 5:14 ...Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.

18 Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people. 19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.



- **Romans 9:6** For not all who are descended from Israel are Israel. 7 Nor because they are his descendants are they all Abraham's children. On the contrary, "It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned." 8 In other words, it is not the children by physical descent who are God's children, but it is the children of the promise who are regarded as Abraham's offspring.
- **9** For this was how the promise was stated: "At the appointed time I will return, and Sarah will have a son."



Romans 9:10 Not only that, but Rebekah's children were conceived at the same time by our father Isaac. I I Yet, before the twins were born or had done anything good or bad—in order that God's purpose in election might stand: 12 not by works but by him who calls—she was told, "The older will serve the younger." 13 Just as it is written: "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated."



Romans 9:30 What then shall we say? That the Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have obtained it, a righteousness that is by faith; 3 I but the people of Israel, who pursued the law as the way of righteousness, have not attained their goal. 32 Why not? Because they pursued it not by faith but as if it were by works.



Galatians 4:21 Tell me, you who want to be under the law, are you not aware of what the law says? 22 For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by the slave woman and the other by the free woman. 23 His son by the slave woman was born according to the flesh, but his son by the free woman was born as the result of a divine promise.

24 These things are being taken figuratively: The women represent two covenants. One covenant is from Mount Sinai and bears children who are to be slaves: This is Hagar.



- Galatians 4:25 Now Hagar stands for Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present city of Jerusalem, because she is in slavery with her children. 26 But the Jerusalem that is above is free, and she is our mother... 28 Now you, brothers and sisters, like Isaac, are children of promise. 29 At that time the son born according to the flesh persecuted the son born by the power of the Spirit. It is the same now. 30 But what does Scripture say? "Get rid of the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son."
- **3 I** Therefore, brothers and sisters, we are not children of the slave woman, but of the free woman.

John I:II He came unto his own, and his own received him not. **I 2** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name

Religion is man's way of earning what Jesus has already freely provided for us – no one is justified by their own works or obedience

You receive your inheritance by believing you are in Christ, the finisher of the New Covenant
