

The Four Beasts Around the Throne



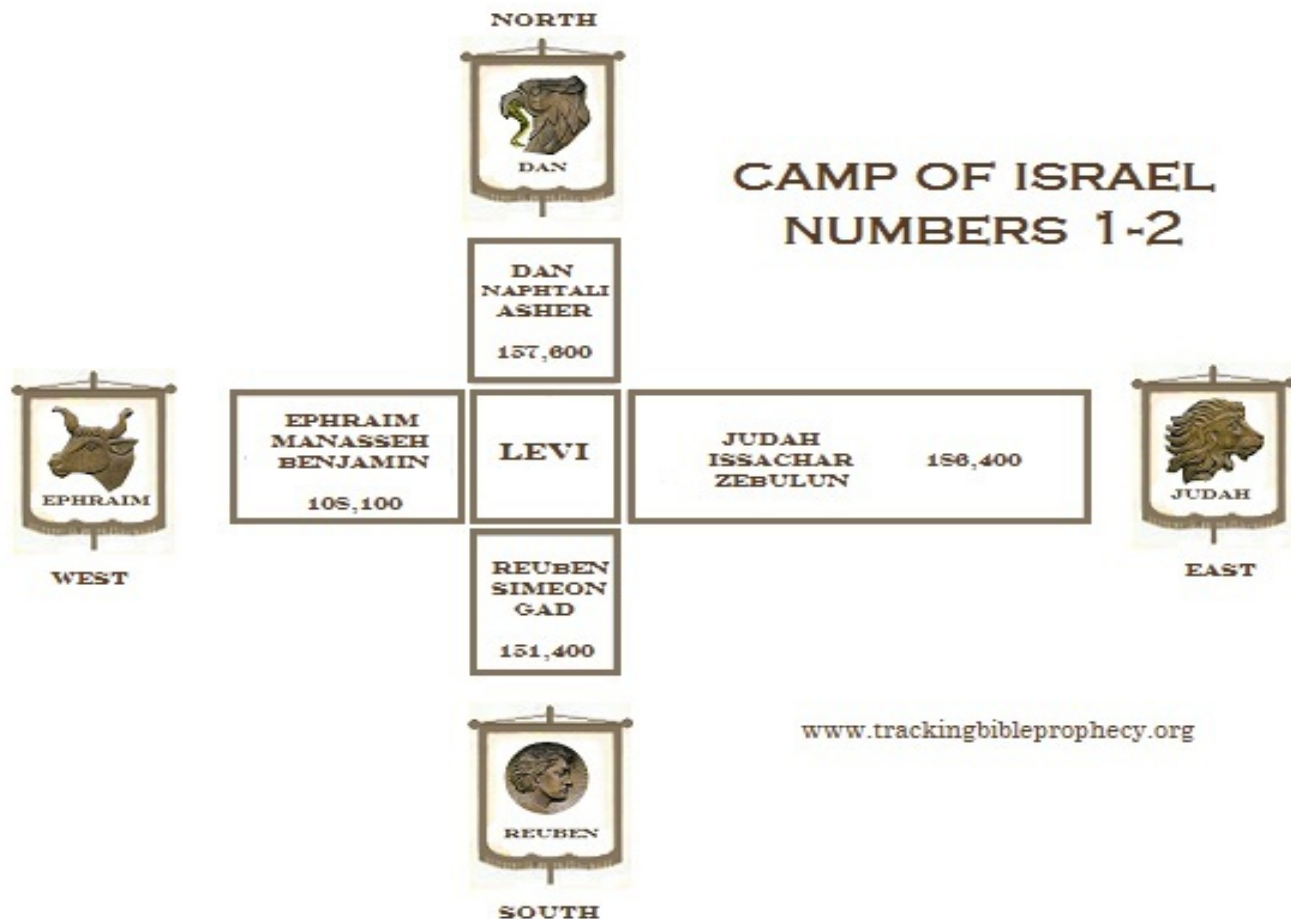
Revelation 4:6 And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. **7** The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. **8** The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within.



Hebrews 8:4 For if He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are priests who offer the gifts according to the law; **5** who serve the copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. (Exodus 25) For He said, “See *that* you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain.”

In Matthew, Jesus is portrayed as the King of the Jews. (Lion on the East)

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David *are* fourteen generations, from David until the captivity in Babylon *are* fourteen generations, and from the captivity in Babylon until the Christ *are* fourteen generations.



**In Mark, Jesus is portrayed as the lowly servant,
or Ox on the cross (Ox West)**

**There is no lineage listed because a servant does
not need a lineage or family pedigree**



**In Luke, Jesus is portrayed as the son of man.
So the genealogy goes all the way to Adam**

Luke 3:23 Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry* at about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) *the son of Joseph...*

38 *the son of Enosh, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God.*



**In John, Jesus is portrayed as the Son of God.
So His genealogy is eternal, no beginning and no end**

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2** He was in the beginning with God.



John 1:1 In the beginning was the **Word (logos)**, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2** He was in the beginning with God.

HELPS Word-studies

3056 *lógos* (from **3004** *légō*, "speaking to a conclusion") – a *word*, being the expression of a *thought*; a saying. **3056** *lógos* ("word") is preeminently used of *Christ* (Jn 1:1), expressing the *thoughts* of the Father through the Spirit.

[**3056** (*lógos*) is a common term (used 330 times in the NT) with regards to a person sharing a message (discourse, "communication-speech"). **3056** (*lógos*) is a broad term meaning "*reasoning expressed by words.*"]



John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: **13** who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 And the **Word (logos)** became flesh and dwelt among us

The message, saying or logic about your life, finances, joy, restoration, protection is Jesus

You are a joint-heir and full Son of God. You are married to Jesus and can use His name.
