In **Genesis 24** Abraham (The Father) sends His servant Eleazar (Gods Helper, Comforter) with all his Master's goods to a city called Nahor (breath) to find a bride for Isaac (His Son.)

When the stone (the ministry of death written and engraved on stones) was rolled away, Lazarus or the Holy Spirit was sent and we became the Bride of Christ and became a joint heir of all The Father's goods.

43 Jesus cried with a loud voice, “**Lazarus, come forth!**”

44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, “**Loose him, and let him go.**”
