## Effortlessly and Accurately Hear God – Part 2

**Psalm 37:4** Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.

**5** Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring *it* to pass. Most people have an Old Covenant idea of Lordship. We pray, fast, seek God's voice.
