

# Christmas 2019 – Understanding The True Meaning of The Lamb Heals Every Area of Our Lives



**Luke 2:8** Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. **9** And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. **10** Then the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. **11** For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. **12** And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger.”

**Luke 2:13** And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: **14** “Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!”

**15** So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, “Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us.”



**Genesis 35:16** Later, they set out from Bethel, and while they were still some distance from Ephrath, **Rachel (female lamb)** began to give birth, and her labor was difficult. **17** During her severe labor, the midwife said to her, “Do not be afraid, for you are having another son.”

**18** And with her last breath—for she was dying—she named him **Ben-oni.(son of sorrow)** But his father called him **Benjamin.(son of my right hand)**

**19** So Rachel died and was buried on the way to Ephrath (that is, Bethlehem). **20** Jacob set up a pillar on her grave; it marks Rachel’s tomb to this day.

**21** **Israel** again set out and pitched his tent beyond the **Tower of Eder.**

When married to the law, there is slavery, hard and toilsome labor (evil)

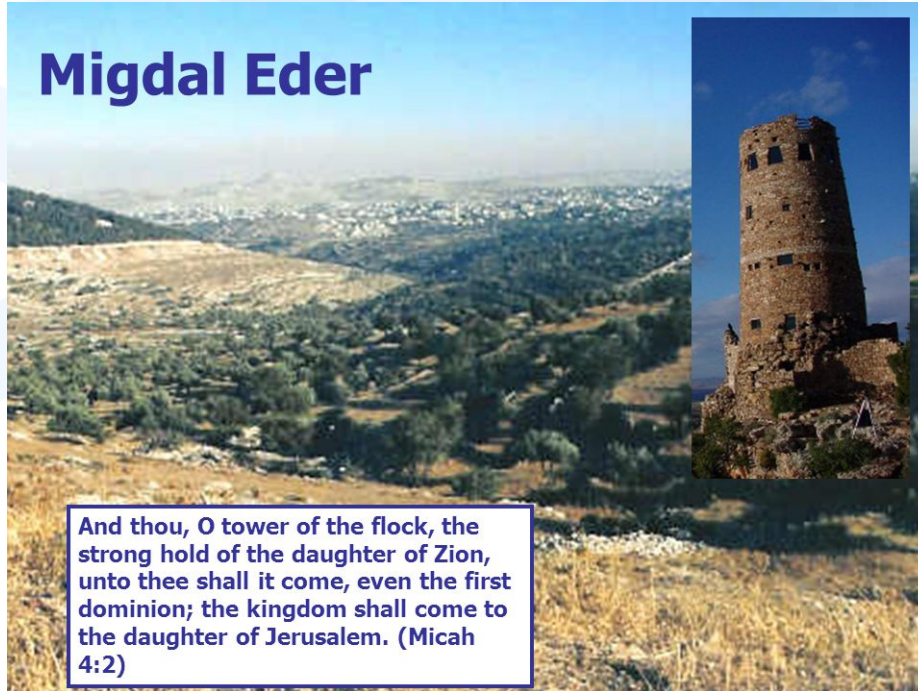
